- ✓ All applicants will be notified shortly after 12th March 2020 and advised if they have made it to a shortlist of finalists.
- ✓ All shortlisted finalists must attend a judging day. Your category Judge will contact you regarding the date & time.
- ✓ The winner will be announced at the IWIB Business Women's Awards Day on Friday 15th May 2020 – all finalists are to attend the Awards Presentation.
- ✓ A Judging Panel made up of well respected and experienced members of the Illawarra business community will judge the awards. Two (2) judges will conduct the interviews with the successful candidates who reach this stage.

- All must be emailed to events@iwib.com.au with the **FULL APPLICATION** in **ONE PDF FILE** to be received before **5pm Monday 9th March 2020 deadline**.
- No entries after this date will be accepted.
- Only applications/entries which are emailed will be accepted (no hard copies in mail or dropped off)
- You will receive confirmation of receipt of your application by email, within 48hours. If you do not receive this confirmation, email us at events@iwib.com.au
- The IWIB Businesswomens Awards are free to enter and open to any female over the age of 18 provided they operate or work as an employee in a business located in the *Illawarra.
- IWIB defines the *Illawarra area to cover the local governments of Wollongong, Shellharbour, Kiama & the Shoalhaven. Applicants must conduct their business in these areas of local government.
- The business can be a sole trader, a private or public limited company, a partnership or limited liability partnership, a business unit within a company or a not-for-profit organisation. Businesses can operate in any trading sector.
- It is a condition that entrants must declare whether they, or the business they represent, are involved in (or could be involved in) any dispute or judgement that could in any way significantly interfere with the proper conduct of the Illawarra Women in Business Businesswomen Awards.
- Responsibility within the scope of these conditions cannot be accepted for any failure of confidentiality. Entrants will be expected to protect those aspects of their business that may be patentable, registerable or otherwise secret and governed by intellectual property, copyright or similar legislation.
- All information provided will be considered as confidential by Illawarra Women in Business and will only be accessible to the directors of Illawarra Women in Business and to the Judging Panels. Judges will observe the requirements of confidentiality and will declare any possible conflict of interest.
- Winners may refer to the competition in their own publicity material following approval by the organisers of such material.
- By entering the competition, applicants agree that their name may be held on an awards database.
- By entering the competition, applicants agree that their name and photo may be used in any future promotion of IWIB and similar IWIB awards, and used in any media releases associated with IWIB.
- There can be no appeal against the decisions of the judges and these decisions must be accepted as final in respect of all matters concerning the Illawarra Women in Business Businesswomen Awards, including the interpretation of the conditions of entry.
